2023 Sharing the Gospel

Here at Impact we have many ways to help people. We want to help them with the real problems they face. Problems of family crises, migration, unemployment and things like addictions, and substance abuse. While we do that we preach the gospel to them, what we really want is to wash the feet of all those who cross the doors of our buildings so that they see Jesus in us and thus surrender to Jesus. This is sometimes a quick and easy process, other times it takes a long time. For example, in the case of Lidia, she is a woman who came for help years ago because her husband had beaten her and so he was in jail for that reason. I went to visit him in jail and then he came out and we started a Bible study for several weeks. Unfortunately he decided that they no longer wanted to continue, and I no longer saw them. Nowadays, there is an elderly couple that I am studying the Bible with and they said that they had a daughter who had lost both of her legs because of diabetes. So she was seriously ill in the hospital, so I went to visit her and to my surprise it was the same woman who 8 years ago was in my office studying the gospel with her husband. Now her husband abandoned her and she is still at home struggling with the consequences of being seriously ill and very willing to study the Bible with me. Now she is attending the church. God has multiple ways of bringing his children to his feet.

This is a Family who came a year ago from Colombia. The mom



passed away from cancer. We did support this family in their process when she was dying and four of them got baptized.

I am still working with them. The Cardenas family is a great family. They are serving in many ways. Pray for them.



We are very happy because God has been doing amazing things these past few months. He has been bringing many of his children into his kingdom and many have been baptized. Last year 52 people gave their lives to Christ by getting baptized, and in these four months of this year we have had 49 baptisms. At Impact we believe that these are all works of God, and that we are not able to convince anyone. The people that are baptized don't do it because we are good or because we are persuasive. We are simply ambassadors of the Good News that Jesus saves and is ready to receive those who believe.

We are doing the best we can to continue serving these new brothers and sisters in Christ, as we know that it takes a village to raise a child and it is the same with these new Christians. We are also continuing our efforts to preach, not with pressure, manipulation, or coercion, but rather with the love of Jesus. Please pray for our efforts!"

This work is not ours, it is about what God can do to convince a person of His love, we cannot convert anyone, that is the work of the Holy Spirit.


Several people come to the waters... We're amazed by God's grace
