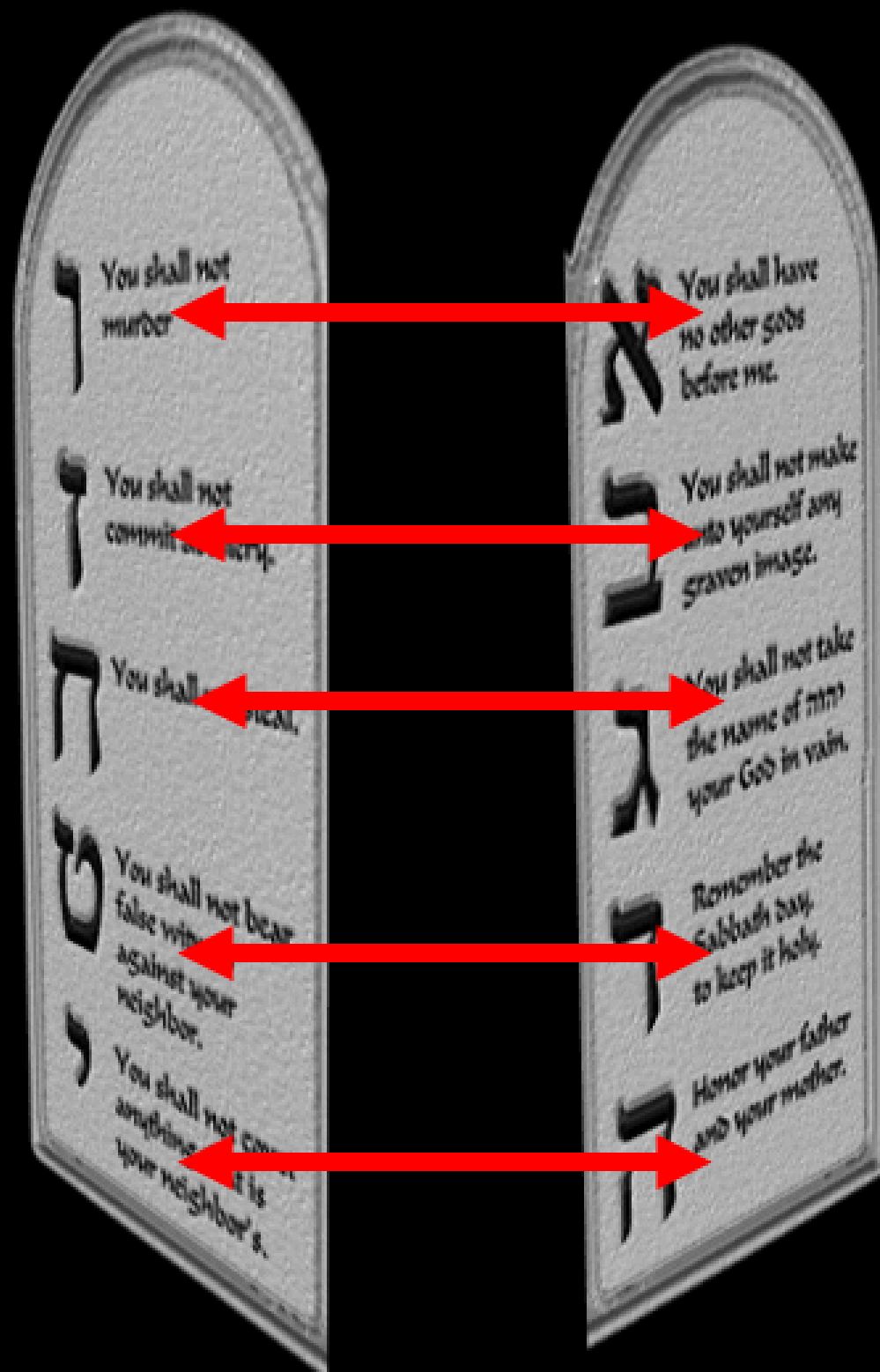

---

Be careful of the “truths” you hear in culture. They may be omitting the bigger picture.

so are my ways higher than your ways  
and my thoughts than your thoughts.





The truth according to Job:

---

Suffering may not be about you.

**Job 1: 8** Then the Lord said to Satan, “Have you considered my servant Job?”

**Your suffering**  
is never an indicator God does  
not love you.

**Job 1: 8** Then the Lord said to Satan, “Have you considered my servant Job? **There is no one on earth like him**; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil.”



**Job 1: 13-16** Live stock taken. Servants killed

**Job 1: 18-19** Sons and daughters die.

**Job 2: 7** Painful sores

**Job 2-37** --Wife and friends turn on Job

The truth:

---

The pain for Job was severe but was a minority of his experience.

We must always put (temporary)  
pain within the overall blessing of  
God's goodness.





**Job 38: 4** “Where were you when I laid the earth’s foundation?

Tell me, if you understand.

8 “Who shut up the sea behind doors when it burst forth from the womb...

33 Do you know the laws of the heavens?

Can you set up God’s dominion over the earth?

**The truth according to Job:**

---

**We are not God.**

**Submission is the only proper  
response.**



**Job 42:** Then Job replied to the Lord:  
2 “I know that you can do all things;  
no purpose of yours can be thwarted.

6 Therefore I despise myself  
and **repent** in dust and ashes.”

**Job 42: 7** After the Lord had said these things to Job, he said to Eliphaz the Temanite, “I am angry with you and your two friends, because **you have not spoken the truth about me**, as my servant Job has.



**One last thought:**

**Truth is not a concept.**

**It's a person.**



**John 14: 6** Jesus answered, “I am the way and **the truth** and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

**John 8: 31** To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, “If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. **32** Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”
