life by God for a specific purpose.

**Hebrews 12: 7** Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father?... 10 God disciplines us for our good, **in order that we may share in his holiness.** 11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, **it produces a harvest of righteousness** and peace for those who have been trained by it.

**Deuteronomy 8: 2** Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years, to humble and **test you in order to know what was in your heart**, whether or not you would keep his commands.

# Two Reasons God Tests Us

---

(1). That He may “know” us.

The God of grace still wants to  
know you  
even when your heart is prone to  
sin and wandering.

**Exodus 15:** 22 Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea and they went into the Desert of Shur. For three days they traveled in the desert without finding water. 23 When they came to Marah, they could not drink its water because it was bitter. (That is why the place is called Marah.)

**Exodus 15: 24** So the people grumbled against Moses, saying, “What are we to drink?”

25 Then Moses cried out to the Lord, and the Lord showed him a piece of wood. He threw it into the water, and the water became fit to drink.

**There the Lord issued a ruling and instruction** for them and put them to the test.

Often, God's tests come in the form of a law or command.
